Extended abstracts may refer to a chapter of your dissertation or any other empirical work. The conference will feature thematic sessions and poster sessions, organized based on the submissions received.

Poster sessions are designed to provide PhD students in the earlier stages of their

research with an opportunity to present their work in an engaging and constructive format. Thematic sessions will group papers on related topics, bringing together diverse methodological perspectives. Each thematic session will include a senior researcher and a PhD participant as discussants to foster detailed and collaborative feedback.
